

2022-2023 STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY




1. The teacher's approach to teaching







Count of Syllabus completed [Teachers inform students about course outcomes and programme outcome, programme




3. Teachers identify students' strengths and encourage them by providing the right level of challenges










